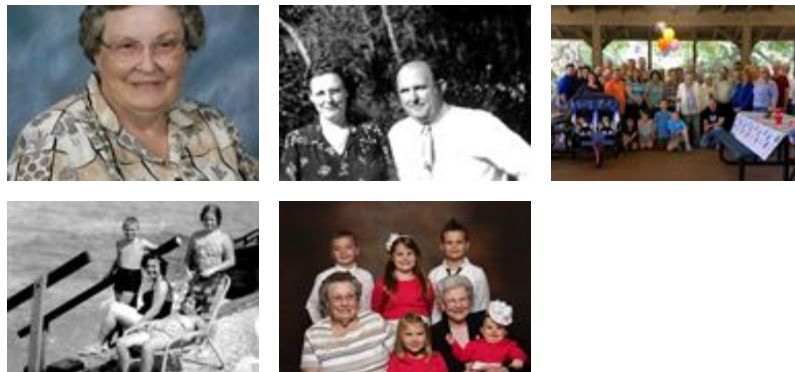
“ *I have many fond memories of Ease. Just to name a few.... I
