Anne “Coach” St. Charles, 67, of Plant City, Florida, born in Tampa on November 4, 1951, entered into eternal rest on November 8, 2018. She was a 1969 graduate of Plant City High and then University of South Florida, where she received her degree in Physical Education. She was employed with Cork Elementary School and was Teacher of the Year in 2000. She retired from Hillsborough County Schools after 40 years of teaching. Anne loved to travel and photography was her passion. She won many awards for her photographs, and especially liked to photograph the 17th century historical re-enactments that she and her friends participated in. She was preceded in death by her parents Vernon and Josephine St. Charles. She is survived by her brother Larry St. Charles and sister-in-law Glenda; and one niece, Aprille Michele Shields and husband Tony.
