



Mr. Arthur C. "Art" Gee Jr.

April 16, 1932 - August 25, 2017

Arthur C. "Art" Gee, Jr., 85, of Lithia, Florida, born in 1932 in Waverly, Florida, during the Great Depression, entered into eternal rest on August 25, 2017.

He graduated from Sebring High School where he lettered in baseball and football. He continued his enjoyment of sports as a baseball coach for many years at East Point Little League. He was also the District 13 Chief Umpire as well as, the District 13 Administrator.

He was a veteran of the United States Navy where he served during the Korean War and saw combat at Inchon Harbour under General Douglas MacArthur. After the Navy, he went to work for Pan American Recovery in the Merchant Marine at Cape Canaveral and participated in the early Atlas Centaur program, which was the beginning of NASA's manned space missions. He retired from Cargil after 30 years of service where he was the Supervisor of the Ammonia Plant Department, and was an expert in the assembly and operations of the plants that produced ammonia in the Fertilizer industry. He finished his career as the Weighmaster for the Tampa Port Authority serving 17 years.

He married the love of his life Lynda Freeman in 1958, and he loved his family dearly. He was an avid golfer, fisherman, gardener, and citrus grower. He was proud of his citrus grove where he sold his annual harvest to the orange juice

industry. He was a member of Browning Road Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Lynda; sons, David, Larry, and Mark, and their families including 5 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren; and 5 siblings. 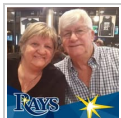
