Betty Jo Prosch Jones, 90, of Plant City, Florida, born on July 1, 1933, joined her Heavenly Father on October 28, 2023. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt and friend. She grew up in Plant City on a crop farm where she worked for her daddy picking strawberries before school and banging on pots in the fields to keep the birds away. She graduated from Turkey Creek School in 1950 where she met the love of her life, James Anak "Sonny" Jones, while playing the bells in the school band. They later married in 1951. She worked for the Hillsborough County School District for 40 years. She was first a librarian at Turkey Creek High School and then a homeroom teacher. In 1961, she opened J.S. Robinson Elementary School as the school's Secretary and remained there until she retired in 1997. Starting in 1971, she was the hostess for the East Hillsborough County Law Enforcement banquet during the years it was held at J.S. Robinson Elementary. She was an active member of Turkey Creek First Baptist Church. She enjoyed playing the piano, working on beautifying her yard, planting flowers, and traveling. She had a love for crocheting and spent hours making gifts for many. She will forever be remembered as the most gracious hostess, having such a big heart, and her uncanny ability to make everyone she met feel special. She loved her community, her friends and especially her family. She was preceded in death by her husband, James Anak "Sonny" Jones, her parents, Herman & Doris Prosch, her brother, Richard Prosch, her sister, Esther Farkas, granddaughter, Kimberly Waters, and grandson, Justin Jones. 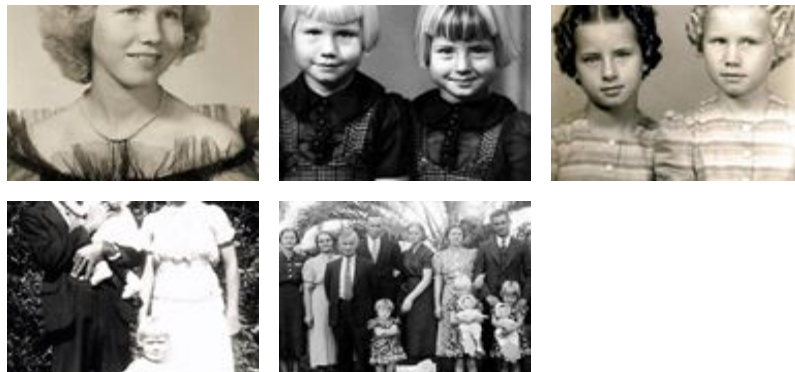
