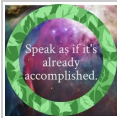

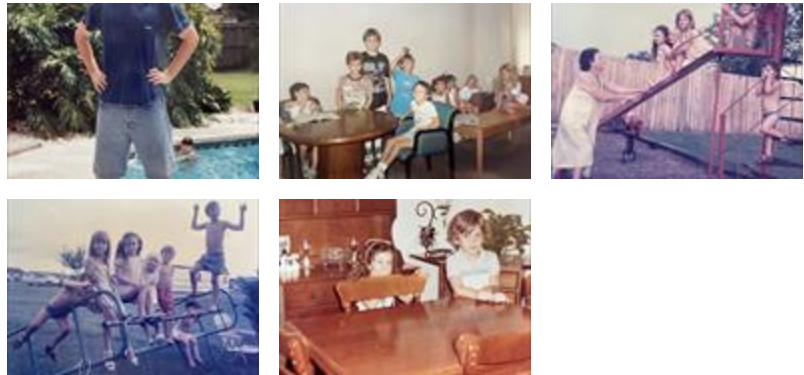

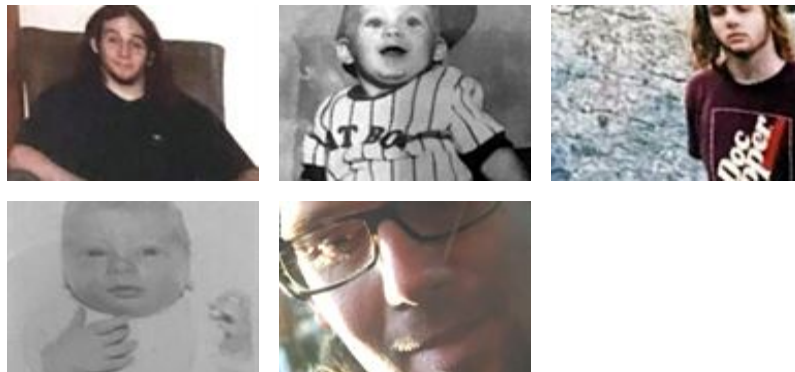

Bobby was one of the first people we spoke to the day we came to Randall's children's hospital and quickly that first week of being admitted became a familiar face. At first I wasn't sure what to think of him(my brain was in a terrified state with my son) and pretty quickly I picked up on what a teddy bear he was. He was always so kind every time we would show up and walk up to the desk where he was more times then he wasn't when we are there. He even started remembering my sons name since December. My son lost his hair in January and Bobby went out of his way to tell him how cool he looked and how being bald was awesome (my son was 4 at the time, now 5). My son saw a picture of him and knew he was and for a small kid that means you have to stand out to the kid. My heart broke seeing this happens and to him out of all people. He was a good man and I'll always remember how he protected us even when it meant the ultimate sacrifice.
