



Ms. Brenda Ann Cuthbertson

September 5, 1950 - January 24, 2023

Brenda Ann Cuthbertson died of complications from frontotemporal dementia in New Port Richey on January 24, 2023. She was born Brenda Ann Johnson to Ellany and Wayne Johnson in Brooksville on September 5, 1950, and she had one brother (Mark). Brenda lived in Brooksville, Plant City, Decatur (TX), Bridgeport (TX), Ashburn (GA), Plant City (again), Lakeland, Lithia, Heber (UT), Salt Lake City (UT), Valrico, and Hudson in that order, and she was a graduate of Plant City High School. Brenda first met Jim Cuthbertson while working at Hull's Jewelry Store in Plant City, and they married on November 14, 1970. They had two sons (Daniel and Timothy). To her five beloved grandchildren, Brenda is known as Gi-Gi. She developed a special bond with her mother-in-law, Vera Mae Cuthbertson (Carpenter), and Brenda and Jim had a 40+ year marriage until his death in August 2011.

Brenda was quick to laugh at herself and with others. She worked at South Florida Baptist Hospital and Swindle Diagnostic Center, and she played piano and taught Sunday School (youth) for many years at Keysville Assembly of God. Brenda loved shopping -particularly for shoes, some of which even fit comfortably. Others she made "fit" if the sale was good enough, but the store lacked her true size. She also had a special affinity for dogs none more than her dearest Angelina- and horses; consequently, Brenda enjoyed rodeos, and it didn't matter if they were small or large competitions. She loved attending other sporting events, as well, and she made her presence known, whether at

a high school basketball game with only a couple dozen other parents or at Ben Hill Griffin Stadium with 89,000 other raucous Gator Fans. Brenda skydived for her 50th birthday, despite being terrified of heights, and she liked to snow ski.

She was preceded in death by her father (Wayne Johnson) and her husband (Jim Cuthbertson).

Brenda is survived by mother (Ellany Johnson), brother (Mark Johnson), sons (Daniel and Timothy Cuthbertson), daughter-in-law (Jennifer Cuthbertson), grandchildren (Harper, Cate, Sam, Penelope, and Sadie Lou), partner (Rob Hodges), and best friend (Sue Ann Brock).

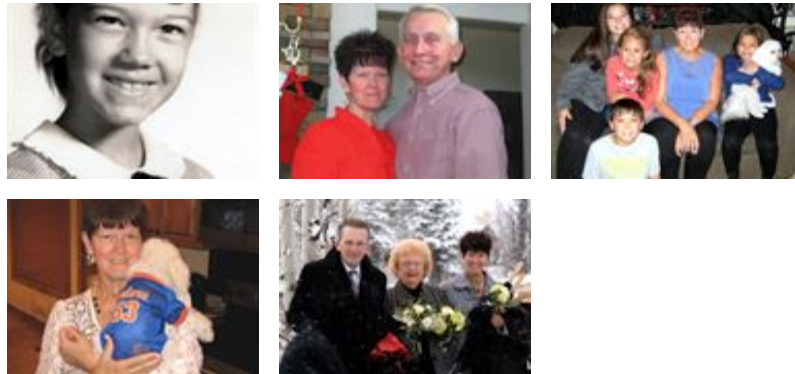
