Reverend Charles R. Andrews, 87, of Plant City, Florida, born on October 5, 1930 in Ft. Myers, became satisfied on July 19, 2018. He was a graduate of the Atlanta Christian College, a member of Pleasant Grove Assembly of God, and an ordained minister with the Peninsular Florida District and the Mississippi District Councils of the Assemblies of God. He was a financial steward with AGL Financial, Oral Roberts University, and the Salvation Army.
