January 12, 1930 - May 13, 2025

Cleo Eston Willis, Jr. passed away peacefully on May 13, 2025, in Plant City, Florida, at the age of 95 surrounded by his family.

Born on January 12, 1930, in Georgia. Cleo faced early challenges with strength and resilience. After losing his parents, at only twenty-one he assumed the responsibility of raising his five younger siblings with unwavering dedication. These formative experiences shaped a life marked by perseverance and deep-rooted values.

In 1956, he married Judy Lumley, beginning a loving union that lasted 68 years. Together they built a life grounded in love and shared purpose. Cleo is lovingly remembered by Judy; their children Jody (Lynne), Julie (Larry), and Holly (Dirk); four grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and four sisters.

Affectionately known as “Junior” to friends and “Poppy” to family, Cleo was a man of vision and determination. He founded what became one of the largest drywall companies in Florida and constructed hundreds of homes throughout the Plant City area. However, it was the treehouse he built for his grandchildren that brought him the greatest joy—a quiet testament to his enduring love for family.

Cleo's life reflected a deep spiritual foundation and steadfast commitment to those he held dear. His legacy endures through the lives he touched and the lasting impact of his work.
