



Mrs. Connie Kindberg

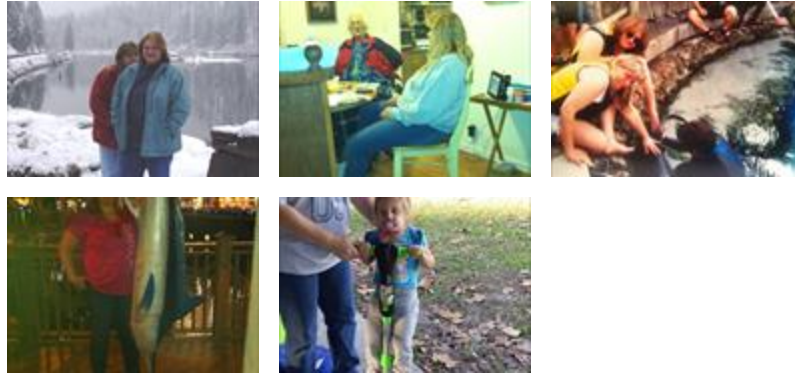
November 25, 1965 - November 21, 2025
