August 11, 1928 - March 14, 2018

David G. Howe, 89, of Plant City, Florida, born in Wilmington, Massachusetts on August 11, 1928, went to be with the Lord on March 14, 2018. He grew up during the Great Depression in the Panama Canal Zone. He graduated Castle Heights Military Academy in Lebanon, Tennessee in 1946, and attended Caltech and Emory Universities. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force, having served during the Korean War. He was a flight engineer for Eastern Airlines; in 1960 he joined Boeing as a telemetry engineer, and in 1963 joined Wichita as an engineer for Beechcraft, working on the first turbo prop aircraft. He came back home to Florida in 1969, and moved to Plant City in 1974. As an inventor, pilot, and engineer, he earned many accolades, including the prestigious Charles Taylor award presented by the FAA. He retired from Cypress Aviation in Lakeland where he designed repairs and modifications for aircraft. His passions included woodworking, like designing cabinets, tinkering in the barn, helping friends and neighbors fix things, watching western movies. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Linda R. Howe; son, Matthew Howe of Plant City; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Terri Howe; and siblings, Charles, Roger, Blanch, Muriel, and Dolly.
