David L. Jones, III, 70, of Plant City, passed away June 29, 2022. David is survived by his wife of 47 years, Sue Jean Jones.

David was born October 20, 1951 in Montgomery, Alabama to the late David L. "D.L." Jones, Jr. and Donna Elizabeth Jones.

David was a devoted Christian and man of faith. He was also a loving husband, father, and "Papa" to his grandchildren. 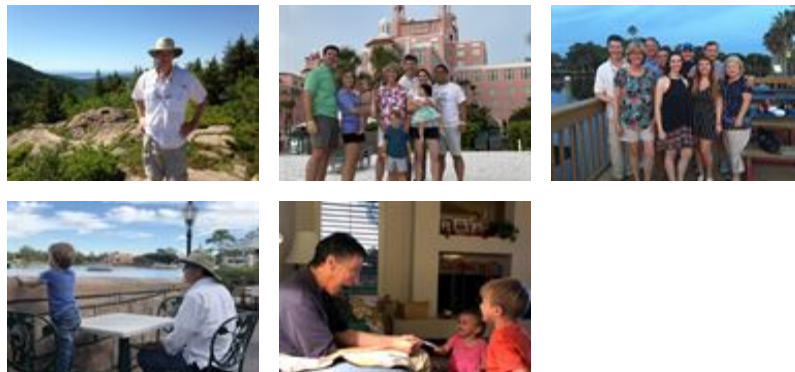

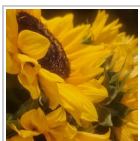
