



Mr. George Stanley Lemasters

November 5, 1929 - October 9, 2024

George Stanley Lemasters passed from this life on October 9, 2024, at the age of 94 in Brandon, Florida. He was preceded in death by his first wife Barbara Jean (Jones) Lemasters; his parents, Ora Vlandingham Lemasters and Lewie Mae (Talkington) Lemasters; his siblings, Edmund, Donald, Kermit, Mary Wright, Clara Roop; and his second wife, Mildred Gross. He is survived by his daughters, Camilla Jeanne (Don) Bunting and Cynthia Dawn Lemasters; three grandsons, Daniel (Heather) Bunting, Benjamin (Hannah) Bunting, and Timothy (Michelle) Bunting; and eight great-grandchildren, Jack, Thomas, Alice, Mary, Rae, Della, Annabelle, and Sammy. George was born in Wetzel County, West Virginia. His mother was a faithful Christian attending the Jacksonburg church of Christ where his brother Edmund served an Elder. At the age of 19, George was baptized into Christ, and decided he wanted his life's work to be as a minister of God's Word. In 1950, he left home and enrolled at Florida College where he focused in Biblical Studies. In 1952, he moved to Barberton Ohio to preach the Gospel where he met his first wife Barbara, and they began their life together and raised their family. Over the next 30 years, he preached at various churches in the Akron area, served as an Elder, and held a secular position for Green Hills Management, navigating the process of selecting burial plots, and offering compassionate guidance to families with end-of-life arrangements. In 1985, he and Barbara moved to Winter Haven, Florida where he worked as an evangelist at the Inman Park church of Christ. After the passing of his wife, Barbara in 2008, he married

Mildred Gross and they lived for 13 years together in Winter Haven until 2020, when they moved to Brandon, Florida to be closer to family. Since that time, he has been a faithful member of the church of Christ at Valrico. Throughout his 75 years of preaching the Gospel, George had a profound impact on others through his spiritual guidance and mentorship. His dedication to helping young preachers with both their biblical knowledge and interpersonal skills reflected his deep commitment to his faith and to fostering meaningful connections. George's unwavering commitment to sharing the gospel and focusing on Jesus, even in his final days, speaks volumes about his faith and purpose. A funeral service will be Friday, October 18, 2024, at 11:00 A.M. at the Church of Christ in Valrico, 1610 S Miller Rd, Valrico, where the family will receive friends at 10:00 A.M.
