novels, as well as completing word puzzles and brain teasers. She was ahead of her time on the importance of healthy cooking and exercise. She loved walking, hiking, and camping, and shared the benefits and joy with her family and friends. 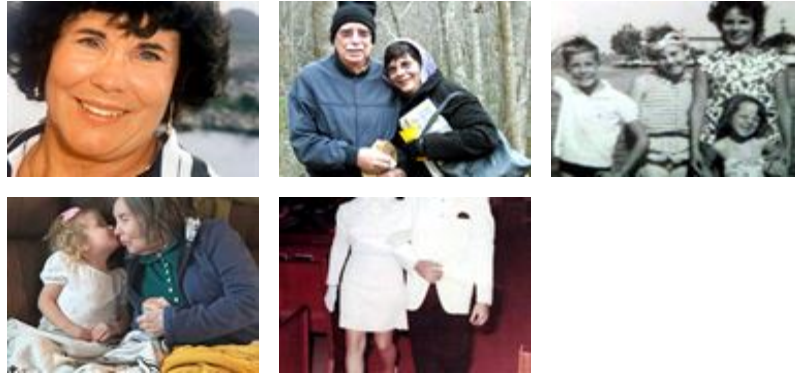
