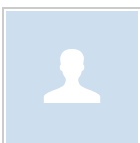

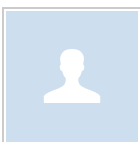

I didn't have family around at that point in my life and they always made their home open to me and made sure that I knew I was welcome. Years later, when I was in college in Montreal, I came to Lakeland to spend a summer with Renee and Mr. Dub and Ms. Gloria. That was so generous on their part! I'm smiling right now as I think about it, the little things, like Ms. Gloria always making sure that there was enough Publix sandwich meat and cheese for us to make sandwiches, we were all so busy all the time but she had a way of making sure everyone was taken care of. Renee and I worked a lot that summer (and Renee was in College on top of that) and they would come by where I worked and tip me "extra" as if they weren't doing enough for me. I have never seen a harder working man than Mr. Dub. I remember there was a house that Renee and I needed to clear up and he put us to shame in that Florida heat cutting and clearing brush. I was dying and he was like "c'mon girls...you can do better!" I don't think I ever shared this with his daughters, but one evening we were sitting by the pool talking for a minute, and he said out of the blue "I don't think my daughters know how much I care about them". I just remembered that. It wasn't the topic of conversation, maybe it was something that was meant for me to remember today. Everyone has different beliefs about what happens after life, but be that what it may I believe that they will be together forever in whichever form that takes on.
