James Floyd Hall, 70, of Plant City, Florida, passed away September 21, 2018. He was born December 11, 1947 in Plant City to Gaines Floyd and Lena Estelle Hall. He graduated from Plant City High School in 1965. Floyd served in the Army and was stationed in Vietnam in 1968. He graduated with a degree in accounting from University of Central Florida.

Floyd was a devoted Christian husband, father and grandfather. He was active in the Plant City community serving on numerous boards over the years. He was honored to be recognized as Plant City's 1993 Citizen of the Year. He was currently Vice President of the Florida Strawberry Festival board and also taught Sunday School for over 20 years at First Baptist Church Plant City. He coached youth sports including baseball, soccer and basketball for 20 years. He worked for Sunshine State Federal Savings and Loan for 33 years and for 27 years was President.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Ann; three children, Amanda (Jason), Sara (Brandon), Justin (Christina) and three grandchildren, Jaxon, Madalyn and Adriana. He is preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Marcellia Hall.

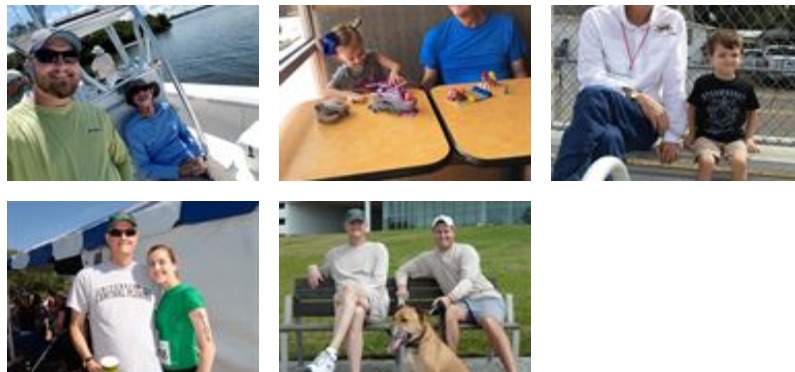
