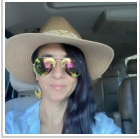


Mr. Jay M. Mertz, Sr.

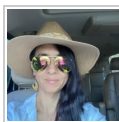

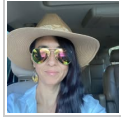
