Jewell Edgemon Farmer, 91, of Plant City, Florida, born on July 23, 1925 in Canal Point, Florida, entered into eternal rest on June 22, 2017. She was a 1943 graduate of Plant City High School, and attended banking courses at the University of Tampa. 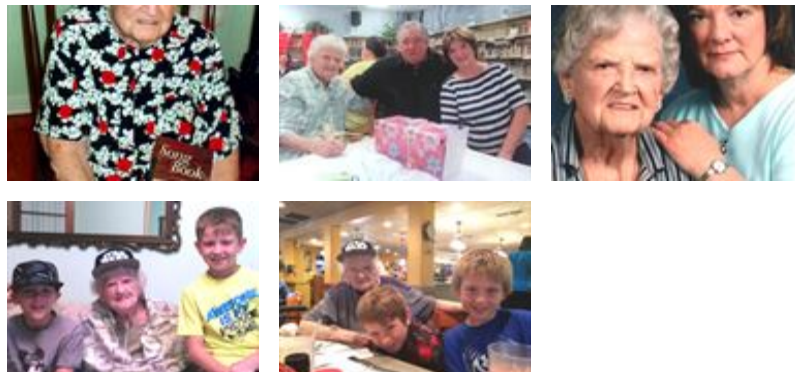
