Joe T Morris, a WWII Marine Veteran, passed away peacefully on April 23, 2020, in Plant City, Florida, surrounded by his loving family. Joe was born on September 12, 1925, in Daisy, Georgia. He served in the South Pacific theater during WWII in the First Marine Division.

He is survived by his wife of 73 years Jean Aaron Morris, his daughters and their husbands Karen and Paul Matches, Susi and Rodger Stephan, Terry and John Retzlaff, four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Joe worked for Texaco Oil Company for 30 years in Tampa and then in Jacksonville.
