



Mr. Larry E. Doak

March 16, 1948 - October 13, 2019

Larry Doak, 71, of Plant City, Florida, born in Parkersburg, West Virginia on March 16, 1948, was received home by His Lord and Savior on October 13, 2019. He was a veteran of the United States Army, having served in the Vietnam War. A graduate of Ohio University, Class of 1970, he started his teaching career as a math teacher at Tomlin Junior High in 1973. Not only was he a math teacher, he served his students as a Coach and Academic Advisor, establishing the National Junior Honor Society at Tomlin. He would eventually retire from Plant City High School in 2010. He was a founding member of GracePoint Plant City, where he served as an Elder, and as a lay leader on the Denominational and Presbytery levels, as well as singing in the choir. He enjoyed spending time with his family, sports, camping, and fishing. He was a quiet, humble man who believed in serving. He is survived by his wife of 49 1/2 years, Ann Doak; children, Melissa "Missy" Bell (Allen, Jr.) of Murphy, North Carolina, and Daniel Allen Doak (Robert C. Derryberry, III) of Orlando; grandchildren, Taylor Bell (Holly), and Aria Bell; siblings, William Doak of Nelsonville, Ohio, Vicki Rollins (David Masten) of Wilmington, North Carolina, and Steven Doak (Erin) of Four Oaks, North Carolina; and many loving nieces, nephews, extended family, and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ron and Naomi Doak. 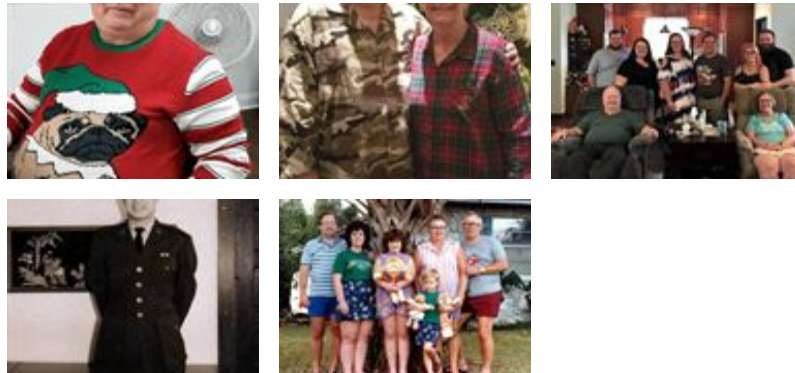

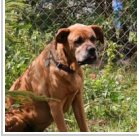
