Leland "Lee" Felton Williams, 68, of Plant City, Florida, born in Tampa on August 14, 1952, entered into eternal rest on July 31, 2021. He was the 2nd generation owner of Felton's Meat and Produce, and a graduate of the University of Florida, earning a Bachelor of Science in Accounting and a minor in Physics. He was the Past President and Melvin Jones Fellow of the Plant City Lion's Club, Past Chairman and Good Egg recipient for the Plant City Chamber of Commerce, board member of Unity in the Community, and member of First Baptist Church Plant City, Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity, and the National Model Railroad Association. He was an avid fan of the Florida Gators, enjoyed model railroading, and was a longtime student of physics and history. He is survived by siblings, Karen Williams Davis (Elliot) and Jeff Williams (Pat); nieces, Kayla Davis, and Cameron Davis; extended family, Stacy Beasley, John Beasley, Laura Beasley (Jake), Jamie Beasley, Easton Elliott, and Tate Elliott; and many other family and friends. He was preceded in death by parents, Felton and Lucille Williams. 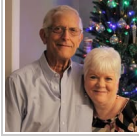

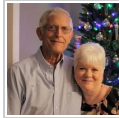

One could always count on Lee when needed. I remember driving to Kentucky with Lee for fraternity business. We stopped in Atlanta and toured the Atlanta Underground which at the time was the "upscale" place to meet and greet young adults. 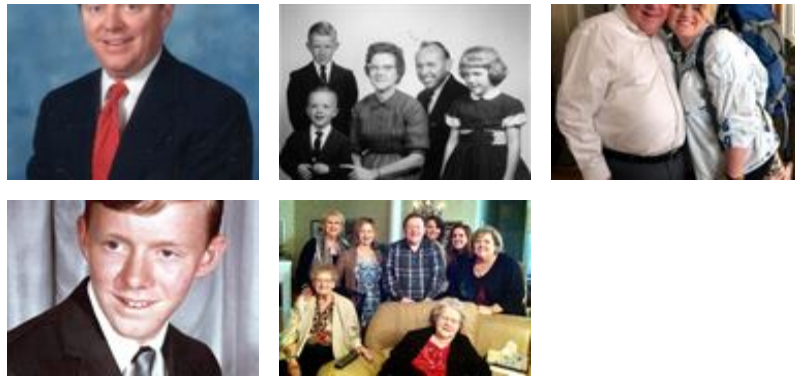

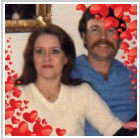
