I wish I could thank her one more time for all she's done for me. I feel such a void; so empty. She will forever be in my heart.

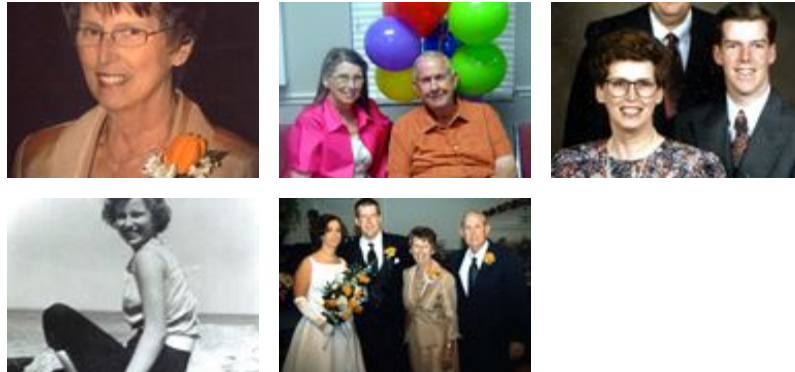
