Lynda Ruth Rogers Fuller, age 72, of Plant City, Florida entered into eternal rest on April 7, 2015. She joined her husband of 51 years Samuel A. Fuller, her parents Mildred Frierson Rogers and Russell Rogers, and grandson Brett Russell Fuller in Heaven. Lynda was a graduate of Plant City Senior High School Class of 1960. She enjoyed organizing many activities including picnics, dinners and reunions for the Class of '60 as well as the monthly class breakfast. She was affectionately known as "the fearless leader" and helped organize the Planters Reunite Reunion for classes 1956 through 1972 held in July 2013 with 635 in attendance. After graduating from Hillsborough County School of Practical Nursing in 1971, Lynda's nursing career continued from 1971 to 2005 where she cared for others on a daily basis. Arts and crafts were her hobby, and she loved making flower arrangements and decorating for Christmas. Lynda was a proud ancestor of a Hillsborough County pioneer family and along with several cousins co-authored the book *Pioneers of Hopewell*. She was a member of Hopewell Baptist Church since childhood and for many years served on the Old Hopewell Cemetery Board of Directors. She loved the Plant City community and volunteered for many organizations including the East Hillsborough Historical Society and Plant City Photo Archives. Lynda was very active and enjoyed being with her family and friends. She loved attending church, taking family trips to Fernandina Beach, traveling and attending senior aerobic classes at the Plant City Rec Center. In her spare time she continued the family's cattle business. Lynda was a dear

wife, mother, grandmother, relative and friend who was always ready to assist those in need. She was a beautiful person who will be missed by all who knew her. She is survived by daughter Kathie Jean Fuller (Jeff Traicoff); sons James Samuel and Timothy Russell (Penny) and Charles Raymond (LeighAnn); grandchildren Brooke, Jeremy and Alex Fuller, Brad and Daniel Cassels; and many other relatives and friends too numerous to mention. After Sam passed, I went to as many of Lynda's appointments as possible. I wanted to be a support to her, as she always was for me, in times of need, and in times of happiness.

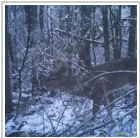
