



Mrs. Mary Helen Law Everidge

July 29, 1929 - August 3, 2023

Mary Helen Law Everidge, age 91, died peacefully on August 3, 2023. Born the first child of three to Earnes and Beulah Law in Vero Beach, Florida, on July 29, 1932. After graduating from Vero Beach High School, where she was a member of the school band, Helen attended and graduated from David Lipscomb College in Nashville, Tennessee. She graduated with a degree in Home Economics. After graduating from college, Helen found that there was an opening for a home economics teacher at Springhead Junior High School in Plant City. She applied for and received that job as the Home Economics teacher. After a short period of time living in Plant City, two close friends and teachers at Springhead kept insisting that Cecil Everidge call Helen Law for a blind date. Cecil finally called her and the "Blind Date" resulted in a very successful and cherished marriage of 67 years. Helen led an active community and church life. She was an active member of the Walden Lake Golf Association where she once made a hole in one on hole number eight. She was also a volunteer at the Florida Strawberry Festival and helped for many years in the Strawberry Festival queen's contest. She was a Past President of the Lions Club Auxiliary. Helen and Cecil were in New York City when someone gave them tickets to "The Price Is Right" television program. She was selected out of the audience to appear on the live television program. After winning the most prizes for the day, she came back the second day to appear on the program again. She was a member of First Baptist Church of

Plant City where she sang in the choir, taught Sunday school, led the PBM Bible study group and served on several committees. When Cecil retired from Reeves Southeastern Corporation, they bought a vacation home in Vero Beach, Florida and enjoyed years of swimming, walking on the beach, watching the Gator Football games with their friends, and glorious sunsets. Helen will be most remembered as being a devoted wife to her husband, Cecil, and a loving and caring mother to her children and grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her husband, Cecil Everidge, and her parents, Earnes and Beulah Law. She is survived by her children Jean Ann (Paul), Billy (Nancy), Linda (Riviere), and Carolyn, 7 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren. She is also survived by her sister, Jean Miller and brother, Ken Law (Ann). A service of honor will be held on Thursday, August 17 at 11:00 A.M. at First Baptist Church Plant City, 3309 James L Redman Parkway, where the family will begin receiving friends at 10:00 A.M. 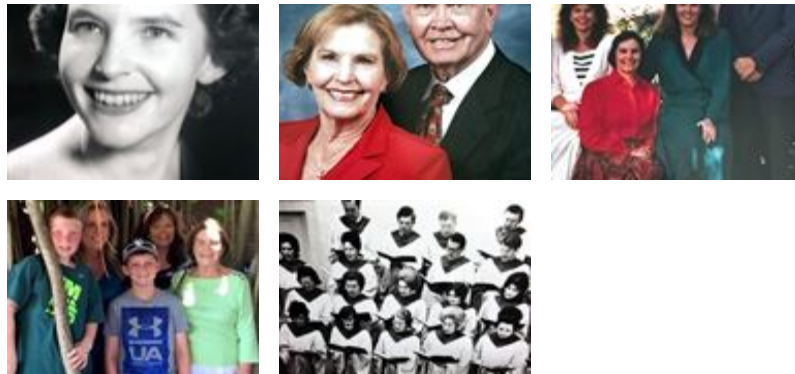
