



Mr. Neil J. Davis

November 25, 1925 - June 29, 2020

Neil J. Davis (“Gator”, to his friends), 94, of Plant City, Florida, born in Bartow on November 25, 1925, went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on June 29, 2020. He attended the infamous Arthur G. Dozier School for Boys, and was the oldest known member of the White House Boys. He was a veteran of the United States Army, Air Force, and Marine Corps, serving in WWII in the military police. He was an investigator with W.C. Crumbley U.S. Marshall’s Office in Tampa in the mid ‘40s. He retired from GTE, where he was a member of IBEW Local 824, serving as Vice President and Chief Union Steward in the early ‘60s. He was a family historian and enjoyed gardening. He was preceded in death by his wife, Sara Coleman Davis; and siblings, William “Bill” Davis, and Peggy E. Smith. He is survived by his children, Alan S. Davis, Carole D. Ellis (William), Brenda E. Davis, and Wayde C. Davis; brother, Dusty W. Davis (Dorothy); 7 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; and close friends, Ed Nelson, Lee Surett, and Jim Crews. Special thanks to the White House Boys Organization for their love and support. 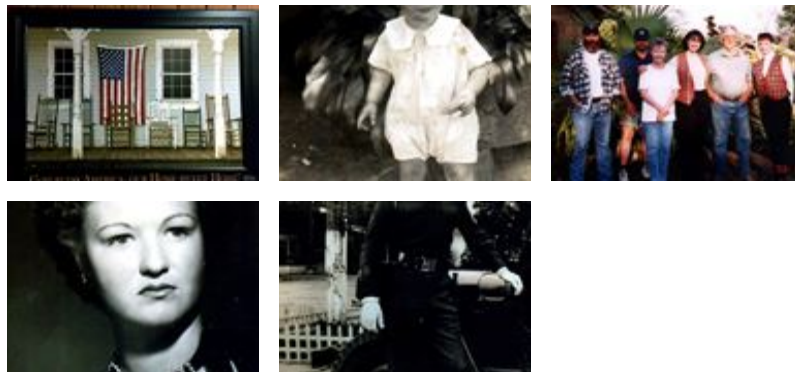

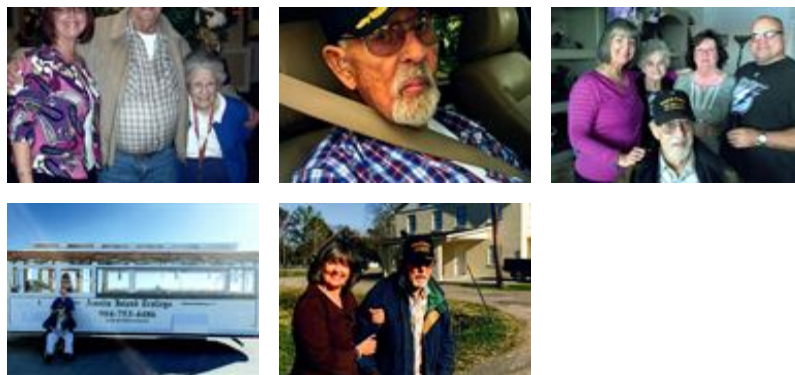
