Raymond Ambrose Alley, Jr., 76, of Brandon, Florida, passed away on Tuesday, June 21, 2016. He is survived by his wife, Linda Jameson Alley; brother, Paul F. Alley, Sr. (Marcia) of Lakeland; sisters, Ann Lee Alley Earnshaw and Jo Alley Sumara (Jim) both of Jacksonville; and several nephews, nieces, grand-nephews and grand-nieces. He was preceded in death by his parents, Reverend Raymond Ambrose Alley, Sr. and Dorothy Shepherd Alley. A native Floridian, he was born in West Palm Beach on June 7, 1940.
