Rebecca "Becky" McIntosh, a cherished mother, wife, and friend, entered heavenly glory on 11/24/2024. She was born in Knoxville, Tennessee to Cecil and Bertha Heath and was the youngest of six children: Catherine, Alice, Earl, Bruce, and Art. All of whom, along with her parents, preceded her in death. Becky attended various schools before settling in Plant City, Florida, where she met and married Lewis "Simmy" McIntosh 53 years ago. A devoted public servant, Becky's early career began at the public library. After becoming a mother, she chose to stay home to care for her children, but her service continued as an active member of First Baptist Church in Plant City. Once her children were older, Becky returned to her beloved community, resuming work at the Public Library eventually retiring after thirty five years of service. Becky had a passion for serving people and making others happy. As a child, she loved playing baseball with the neighborhood boys, and when her children were young, it wasn't uncommon for the neighborhood children to knock on the door, asking if "their parents" could come out and play. Her love for community extended beyond her family. She served as a preschool teacher and a youth leader. She was also a clown for many church events and mission trips, where she taught countless students how to make balloon animals. A talented seamstress, Becky even made her daughter's wedding dress, and she was known as a fixer of all things. Her life was dedicated to enriching others. After retiring from the Public Library, she continued to serve

by leading the church library for many years. She often said her favorite part of the job was meeting and ministering to those who visited. Becky is survived by her devoted husband, Simmy McIntosh, her daughter Serena (Jeff), her son Scott (Elizabeth), and her beloved grandchildren; Kyle, Charley, Dylan, Isabella, and Samuel and many nieces, nephews, family and friends.
