November 4, 1932 - February 13, 2025

Richard Worthington Boyce, 92 of Lithia, went to be with the Lord on February 13, 2025. Born November 4, 1932 in Buffalo, NY, to Nelson and Mary Boyce, Richard's first love was radio. After graduating from high school, Richard attended Houghton College for one year before moving to Florida to attend Florida Bible Institute in St. Petersburg in 1952. While at FBI, Richard became involved with the radio ministry of Faith Temple and Dr. Charles Leaming. He continued in this role well into the 1960's. In 1957, Richard was hired as General Manager at WTWB Radio in Auburndale, a Southern Gospel radio station. In 1958, Richard met Gail Carroll and they married on February 14, 1959. Richard and Gail had three daughters and lived in Winter Haven. Richard was proud of his family. He managed a family singing group, The Melody Three Singers. He was actively involved in the community through board positions at the Salvation Army and the Chamber of Commerce. In 1992, Richard retired from WTWB, and he and Gail moved to Lithia to be closer to their family. Richard died after a brief illness on February 13, 2025—just in time to join Gail in heaven for an anniversary celebration.
