Robert also had enough moments that he could fill an entire highlight reel of mishaps and bloopers, he had a lot of one liners, and his reactions to our pranks were priceless. Peter and I still laugh about the time we all spent together and because of all these moments I am only able to smile when I think of Robert John. My heartbreaks for his family but I am happy to know that he had the love of a wife and daughter waiting for him after we all grew up and left home.

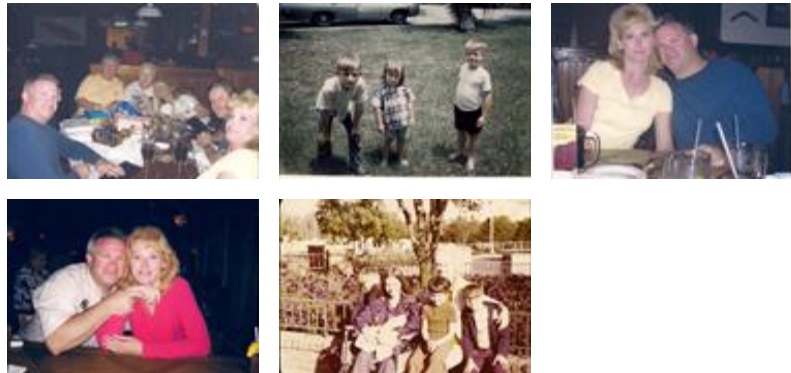
