Rev. Roland H. Blount, a devoted servant of God and beloved family man, transitioned peacefully and pain-free on April 21, 2026, in Plant City, Florida, at the age of 91. Born on March 29, 1935, in Durant, Florida, he lived a life marked by unwavering faith, dedication to ministry, and love for his family.

Despite being blind from an early age, Roland's determination and faith guided him to remarkable achievements. He attended primary grades at Turkey Creek High School and graduated from the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind before earning a ministerial degree from South-Eastern Bible Institute. His education laid the foundation for a lifetime of service as a singer, musician, ordained minister, Christian educator, evangelist, pastor, missionary to Latin America, and media host. Roland's work with Las Buenas Nuevas TV and radio program in Asunción, Paraguay, as well as his contributions as a talent and audio engineer at STAR Media Ministries, Radio Avance, and IBMM left an indelible mark on countless lives.

Roland's ministry was deeply rooted in his reliance on God. As he often said: "Everything the Lord has asked me to do was something I could not do. Yet he would help me do it or he would send somebody to help me do it." This profound trust in divine guidance shaped his quiet strength, gentle spirit, and quick wit—qualities that endeared him to all who knew him.

In addition to his professional accomplishments, Roland found joy in simple pleasures. He was an avid reader of audiobooks and skilled in reading and writing in braille. A hands-on individual with a love for carpentry, whittling, shelling pecans, and holding babies, he embraced life with creativity and resourcefulness.

Roland leaves behind his son Howard Blount; daughter Carla Hood (Todd); grandson Nathan Hood; and numerous extended family members who will forever cherish his memory.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife Evelyn "DeeDee" Blount; granddaughter Angel Ruth Hood; parents Clarence and Kittie Blount; siblings Eloise Yates (Corbon), Bertha Hodge (Lloyd), Iris Vickers (Al), Edward Blount (Frances), Eugene Blount (Mary), Gerald Blount, and Guy Blount (Andrea).

The celebration of Roland's life will be held Thursday, April 30, 2026, at Pleasant Grove Assembly of God, where he worshiped and served, 7051 Turkey Creek Road, Plant City, Florida, 33567. Visitation will begin at 10:00 AM with a memorial service at 11:00 AM. Graveside committal will follow at Pleasant Grove Cemetery.
