Ronald L. Alderman, 69, of Plant City, Florida, born in Tampa on April 7, 1951, entered into eternal rest on March 14, 2021. He was a licensed FL Real Estate Broker, a Licensed FL General Real Estate Appraiser, a member of the CFE and ASA, as well as a partner of McGrath, Alderman and Associates. He was the former Hillsborough County Property Appraiser, becoming the youngest Florida constitutional officer at age 38. He is survived by wife of 46 years, Bonnie B. Alderman; children, Melissa Hardwick (Jason), and Brian Alderman, both of Plant City; grandchildren, Nathan, Noah, Maddie, Dawson, and Bryce; mother, Juanita Alderman of Plant City; and brother, Michael Alderman (Terrie) of Plant City. 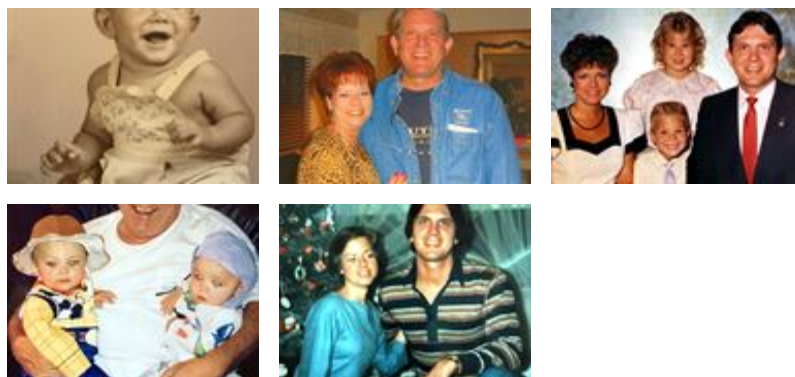
