REYNOLDS, Dr. Roy L., 86, of Plant City, passed away October 16th, 2009. He was born June 13, 1923, in Lakeland, Florida, and was a graduate of Kathleen High School, Florida Southern College, Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and received his Doctorate of Ministry from Luther Rice Seminary. He served in the US Air Force (Army Air Corps) during World War II, He was ordained as a Southern Baptist Minister by Griffin Baptist Church, Lakeland, Fl. Some of the churches he pastored included: Mt. Tabor, Dixieland, and Gapway Baptist in the Lakeland area; Flagami Baptist-Miami,FL; First Baptist Mulberry;Lake Maggiore Baptist-St. Petersburg,FL; Eastside Baptist-Plant City; and Bayshore Baptist-Bradenton,FL. Upon retirement he served as chaplain of South Florida Baptist Hospital for five years. He was a member of Plant City's First Baptist Church. He was past president of the Plant City Kiwanis Club and was a member for over 40 years, and received the George F. Hixson Fellowship award, which is the highest honor a Kiwanis Club can bestow on a member. he was predeceased by a son, Mark. Survivors include his loving wife of 66 years,Leatrice; three daughters: Beverly Hoover (Dr. James), Linda Robert (Roger), both of Plant City, Sandra Chesser pf Cumming,GA, 10 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren.
