He received a Bachelor's Degree in Criminology from the University of South Florida, a Master's in Criminology from St. Leo University, and a Master's in Professional Counseling at Liberty University. He was a member of First Freewill Baptist Church of Tampa, and enjoyed the outdoors, fishing, and hunting. He is survived by children, Ryan O'Keefe, and Ashley O'Keefe, and their mother, Tracy O'Keefe; parents, Tim and Linda O'Keefe; siblings, Michelle Eads (Shannon), and Charles O'Keefe (Gina); fiancé, Crystal Beauchamp; and nieces and nephews, Wesley O'Keefe, Tyler Eads, Michael O'Keefe, Matthew O'Keefe, and Jase Eads. 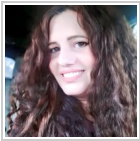

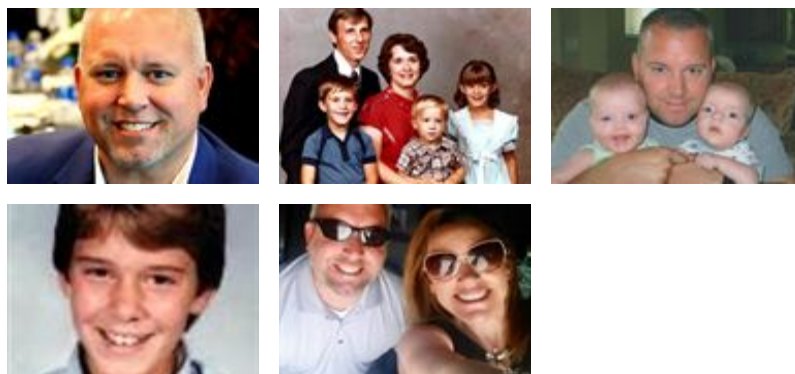

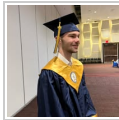
