



Mr. William "Luker" Robert Morris

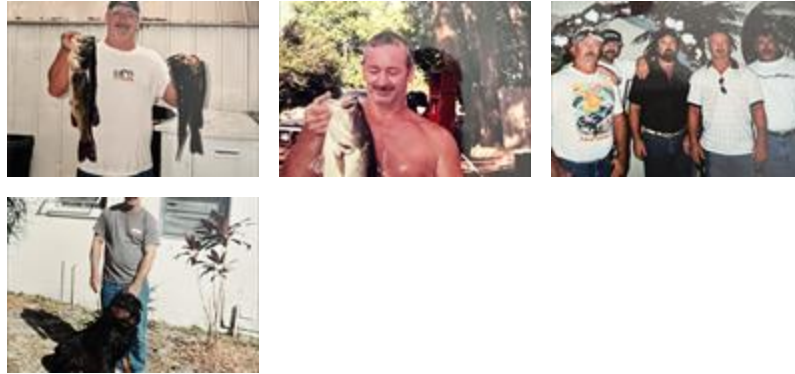
May 2, 1957 - January 1, 2026
